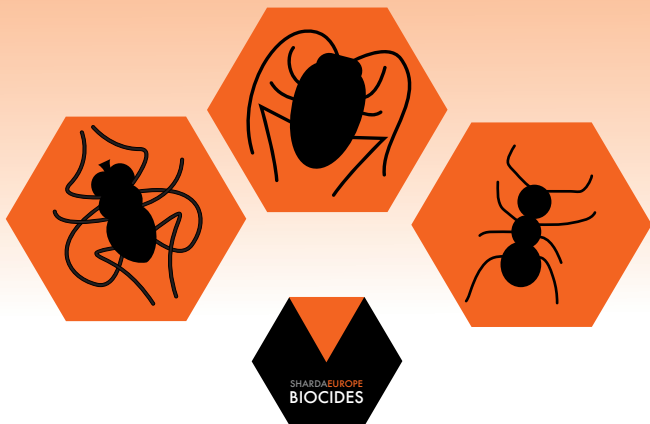

SUSPENSION CONCENTRATE INSECTICIDE AGAINST FLYING AND CRAWLING INSECTS

Uses and Applications DELTA SECT is an insecticide for professional use against crawling and flying insects such as ants, cockroaches, flies, fleas, mosquitos, spiders and wasps. For use in public hygiene areas such as in and around domestic premises, public and municipal buildings, food storage and processing areas and warehouses.

Mode of action: The active substance Deltamethrin, belonging to the Pyrethroid chemical family acts by contact and ingestion. The molecule kills almost instantly by neurotoxic knockdown, blocking the transmission of nerve impulses.

Directions for Use: It is advisable to apply DELTA SECT through devices such as pumps or sprays. Apply the solution along the perimeter, corners and baseboards of the targeted area in addition to any cracks and crevices where insects may nest or hide.

STATUTORY CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL RELATING TO USE. FOR USE ONLY BY PROFESSIONAL OPERATORS FOR USE ONLY AS AN INSECTICIDE

For use against crawling insects dilute 50 – 60ml of product in 5L of water and apply as a surface spray over 100m².

For use against flying insects dilute 40ml of product in 5L of water and apply as a surface spray over 100m².

Target Species	Dilution Rate	Area
Crawling Insects	50-60 ml / 5L of water	100 m ²
Flying Insects	40 ml / 5L of water	100 m ²

Storage: Keep the product in its original packaging out of the reach of children and pets. KEEP IN A SAFE PLACE. Under these conditions, Deltasect can be stored for 2 years.

Packaging: Empty the container thoroughly. Do not use the package again. Disposal of empty containers should be done according to local and national regulations.

Use Precautions: USE ONLY AS DESCRIBED ON LABEL.

Wear suitable protective clothing, gloves and eye/face protection when diluting. This material and its container must be disposed of in a safe way.

Avoid excessive contamination of coveralls. DO NOT CONTAMINATE FOODSTUFFS, EATING UTENSILS OR FOOD CONTACT SURFACES.

Avoid contact with skin.

Avoid contact with eyes.

In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice.

Do not breathe spray.

In case of insufficient ventilation wear suitable respiratory equipment.

Do not empty into drains.

Do not contaminate ground, waterbodies or watercourses with chemicals or used container.

REMOVE OR COVER ALL FISH TANKS AND BOWLS before application. UNPROTECTED PERSONS AND ANIMALS SHOULD BE KEPT AWAY FROM TREATED AREAS UNTIL

SURFACES ARE DRY.

COVER ALL WATER STORAGE TANKS before application. ALL BATS ARE PROTECTED UNDER THE WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. WASH HANDS AND EXPOSED SKIN before meals and after use. If swallowed, seek medical advice immediately and show this container or label.

Cover or remove food before spraying. Diluted insecticide solution should never be kept. A new solution must be prepared every time. May cause transient irritation of skin, eyes and mucous membranes.

Toxic to fish and aquatic wildlife. Do not contaminate ponds/lakes, water pipes or ditches with the diluted product or with the empty container.

First aid: In case of accidental contact with skin or eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water. Seek the advice of a doctor. In case of inhalation other than accidental inhalation, move the patient to fresh air and keep warm. Seek the advice of a doctor. After swallowing: Wash out mouth with water. Do not induce vomiting. Do not give anything to eat or drink. Make sure the airway is clear. Seek the advice of a doctor.
